**ARTICLE I
NAME, AFFILIATION, AND PURPOSE**

Section 1. Name. The name of the organization shall be the Utah Career Development Association (hereafter referred to as UCDA or as the Association).

Section 2. Affiliation. UCDA is a division of the National Career Development Association (hereafter referred to as NCDA) and shall be subject to those provisions of its Bylaws that apply to divisions.

Section 3. Mission and Purpose. The mission of the Utah Career Development Association is to promote career development principles and practices. To achieve this, UCDA fosters a partnership among career development practitioners, counselors, and advisors across the State of Utah in order to establish and improve the standards of professional service in the field of career development. In addition, UCDA will endeavor to:

A. Encourage and foster career development assistance over the life span.

B. Foster a sense of community and shared resources among career

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Camille Odell was appointed Director of the Professional School Counselor Education Program at Utah State University in 2009, after having served prior to that as associate director. She has been a faculty member in USU's Department of Psychology since 1998. As part of her agenda of maintaining a robust and cutting-edge training program for USU school counseling students located across the state of Utah, Camille has focused her efforts on the integration of college and career readiness training into the program of study for USU's school counseling students. In support of the Governor's Excellence in Education initiative, with a goal of having 66 percent of adult Utahans holding a post-secondary degree or certificate by 2020, Camille has focused attention on the need for counselors and other K-12 and aligned post-secondary professionals to have access to high quality college and career readiness training. This led to the creation of a 3-credit professional development course in college and career readiness, which is available for a recording-fee-only rate through Utah State University. Course curriculum is based on a nationally developed and highly regarded curriculum in college and career readiness training. This November Camille will serve on a team representing Utah at the San Diego Convening on School Counseling, which will focus on college and career readiness training for school counselors and other professional educators. Camille serves on the Advisory Boards of the Utah School Counselor Association, the Statewide Advisory and Steering Committee for Comprehensive Guidance, USU's Center for Women and Gender, and Cache Child and Family Support Center.

John R. Rosenberg has been professor of Spanish Literature at Brigham Young University since 1985. He earned his PhD at Cornell University and has taught and written primarily on Spanish letters from 1800 to the present. Current interests include the relationship between verbal and visual arts in Spain, and the literature of Equatorial Guinea. For the last twenty years he has worked with the BYU-Public School Partnership, serving on its management team and receiving in 2005 its Renewal in Practice Award. From 1995 to 2010 he collaborated with the Institute for Educational Inquiry (Seattle) in promoting the democratic purposes of public education and where he served as a Leadership Associate and as an Agenda for Education in a Democracy Scholar. He has received nine grants from the National Endowment for the Humanities to direct intensive summer seminars for schoolteachers, the last five in Madrid. He chaired the Department of Spanish and Portuguese from 1993 to 1997, was associate dean in the College of Humanities from 1997 to 2005, and since 2005 has served as dean. In 2011 he was decorated with the Officer's Cross of the Order of Civil Merit from Spain.
